As a partner you can greet that partner/language in your own language (next to that you can also use the language of that partner or a bridge language like English or Spanish if you want) using the # of your language, the # of the partner you are greeting and the general #EDL2017.

For instance, Fryslân - Catalonia:

Ha goeie Kataloanje! Hola @vxlcat! Hoe giet it mei jim? #Frysk #Català #EDL2017

(Hello Catalonia! How are you doing?)

In that 30 minutes the Catalan partner can answer those greetings and they can also send some extra information about their own language (which they can do all day as well of course).

We think this should work especially on twitter, but maybe it can work on FB and/or Instagram as well.
